As a member of Evolve Gymnastics Academy, you are expected to abide by the following club rules:

- All members must participate within the rules and respect coaches, judges and their decisions.
- All gymnasts must respect fellow club gymnasts and must never verbally abuse others (such as name calling, making fun of, mean comments to others or about others)
- All gymnasts should respect their coach and other members of the coaching team and both listen and perform what they are being asked to do
- Gymnasts should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach, or if they are going to be late or absent.
- Gymnasts must wear suitable attire for training and events as agreed with the coach. Including long hair being tied back, no crop tops to be worn and all body jewelry to be removed.
- Gymnasts should treat all equipment with respect.
- Gymnasts must inform the head coach of any injuries or illness they may have before the warm-up begins.
- Gymnasts must not use bad language.
- Gymnasts should remain with coaches at the end of a session until collected by their parent or guardian, unless it has been pre-agreed to collect from the car park

If this code of conduct is not followed, after 3 occasions it could result in exclusion from the club.
