Coach Code of Conduct

- You must consider the well-being and safety of gymnasts before the development of performance
- You must develop an appropriate working relationship with performers based on mutual trust and respect
- You must at all times hold an appropriate, valid qualification and insurance cover for the level of gymnasts you are coaching
- You must ensure that all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part and ensure all participants are prepared physically and mentally when learning a new skill
- You must display consistently high standards of behaviour and do not use inappropriate language at any time whilst involved with club activities
- You must dress suitably for the sessions, jewellery i.e. necklaces and bracelets should not be worn whilst physically supporting children.
- You must ensure your insurance isn't invalidated by dressing appropriately and not chewing gum whilst coaching
- You must ensure active and enthusiastic coaching and not sit-down during classes
- You must not use your mobile phone within the gym unless you have been designated to take the register or in allowed circumstances
- You must never consume drugs or alcohol immediately before or during a training session, competition or event.
- You must always obtain prior agreement from the parent/guardian of gymnasts before transporting them to training sessions or competitions.
- You must share any concerns or complaints about any aspects of the club through the approved channels and never through the use of social media
- Always report any incidents or accidents immediately
- You must encourage performers to value their performance, development and not just results

Any breach of the Evolve code of conduct will be dealt with on an individual basis.
